BRING A FRIEND WEEK: AUGUST 2ND THROUGH 4TH

It's time for your friend to see where you dance each week. Your friend can be one that already takes dance, would like to try dance, or just wants a good time!

REGISTER FOR FALL! CLASSES BEGIN SEPTEMBER 7TH!

Summer dance is coming to an end soon and Lake Area Dance Center staff is excited to begin fall classes. So many of you have already registered—thank you for choosing us!

For those who have not yet registered, we continue to accept fall registrations. One great opportunity to register is during our Open Houses August 17th through 19th, August 24th through 26th and August 31st through September 2nd from 5-7 p.m. At the same time, you can meet our instructors, order dance shoes, and purchase dancewear and accessories for class. Often the first week of class is extremely busy, so Open Houses are the best time to purchase dancewear and shoes as well as familiarize yourself with the studio. All shoes are 10% off during Open Houses!

Class confirmations will be mailed to you once registered. Coupon payment books will be distributed in class in September. If you have not received your class confirmation by Labor Day weekend, contact the studio. Fall classes begin Tuesday, September 7th.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: FALL ENROLLMENT

Following are commonly asked questions when thinking about registering your student for recreational classes this school year.

Q: How Do I Register?

A: You may register in-person or online at www.lakeareadance.com. See the schedule for days/times available. Complete the form indicating your 1st & 2nd for class day/time. Enrollment is on a first come, first serve basis so register early while there is room available. An annual registration fee (\$12 per individual/\$20 per family) & the first month's tuition are required to hold your student's spot. Classes begin September 7th.

Q: How Big Are Your Classes?

A: Class size varies by age. Tots class size is no larger than 9 students; other classes may have up to 18 students. Typically, assistants accompany instructors for big classes so that each student gets the attention he/she needs & deserves.

Q: What Are Your Tuition Rates?

A: Tuition varies by class & by age and may be found online at www.lakeareadance.com. Please note there is a 5% discount for paying the full year tuition in September. Tuition is due the 1st lesson of each month. A \$5.00 late fee will be applied to your account if tuition is paid after the 2nd lesson of the month. Second family member has \$6.00 monthly discount. Third family member has 50%

monthly discount.

Q: What Should My Student Wear To Dance?

A: Form-fitting yet comfortable dancewear is highly recommended for class. This allows instructors to improve a dancer's technique easily. And it creates a focused, fun environment for learning. Apparel may be purchased at our on-site boutique. Please note there are specific requirements for competitive students.

Q: How Do I Know What Class Choice I Received?

A: Once you have registered, class confirmations will be mailed to you. Phone us if not received by end of August. Coupon payment books will be available at the studio in September.

Q: I'm Not Sure My Child Will Like Dance. What Do I Do?

A: Often, students do a free trial class before joining; call ahead. Or you are welcome to join one of our session classes. Classes are once a week for eight weeks as opposed to once a week for a full school year. Check out our website for the schedule!

Q: You Don't Offer What I Want! What Do I Do?

A: LET US KNOW! Often we create unique dance classes based upon customer interest. *Contact us at lakeareadance@yahoo.com or (651) 762-5366 for any other questions you may have!*

DID YOU KNOW?

- *There is a lost and found area in each dance studio?*

Check the lost and found regularly as we donate unclaimed items to charity regularly. Make sure to label all of your child's items so they do not end up in the lost and found!

- *There is a diaper changing area in one of our restrooms?*

Use the diaper pail near the changing area to dispose of diapers. Also, inquire the front desk if you need diapers and/or wipes.

- *There are coloring books, crayons, games and DVDs available?*

Ask the front desk if these items are needed for your students or his/her siblings. We have a variety of coloring books and DVD selections to entertain everyone.

- *There is an information board near the front entrance for your use?*

Feel free to hang up your business card or to advertise dance shoes for sale. Monthly newsletters and other important studio information is there, too!

- *Young dancers should bring bags with shoes into the classroom?*

Bring a bag that your child can identify easily. It is less likely shoes are lost that way! Dance bags will be available at the on-site boutique.

- *Lake Area Dance Center hosts birthday parties?*

All birthday parties include a dance class, games & goodies for the birthday girl (or boy!) and guests. Time slots are available Saturday afternoons/early evenings. Call (651) 762-5366 or email lakeareadance@yahoo.com for more information.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: PAYMENT POLICIES

Following are commonly asked questions about tuition and costume payments for fall classes:

Q: When Is Tuition Due?

A: Tuition is due the first lesson of each month. Use the coupon payment book and attach it to your cash or check payment. We also accept MasterCard, Visa, and Discover payments. Tuition is the same each month whether there are 3, 4 or 5 lessons during that month. Make-up lessons are available. A \$5.00 late fee will be charged if tuition is not received by the second lesson of the month.

Q: When Are Costume Deposits Due?

A: Costume deposits are as follows. They include the costumes, tights, and accessories.

Q: Are There Tuition Discounts Available?

A: YES! There is a 5% discount for paying the full year tuition in September. Second family member has \$6.00 monthly discount. Third family member has 50% monthly discount.

Q: Do You Mail or Email Statements?

A: You will not receive a statement unless your account is past due. You may also receive a statement if a credit exists and Lake Area Dance Center owes you.

STUDIO GUIDELINES

For the safety and comfort of everyone, we would like to communicate a few guidelines.

Waiting Room Courtesy

- Please help keep the lobby and restrooms clean by throwing trash in the garbage cans.
- Running and rough play is not permitted. Stay safe!
- Encourage children to use "inside voices" throughout the lobby.
- Use coat hook areas for dance bags, jackets, and shoes while in dance class.
- Ask the front desk for baby changing supplies if needed, or activities for children.
- Check out the information boards for studio and local business information!

Dance Class Etiquette

- Arrive a few minutes early to put on dancewear and shoes.
- Encourage young students to use the restroom before class.
- If late, enter class when music is not playing so students are not distracted.
- Observe your student at the viewing window at times during class. They love it!
- Understand instructors are here to answer parent questions, but there may not always be time during class. Call or email us at any time!

Payment Policies

- Statements with a balance or credit will be emailed to you monthly.
- Summer tuition is due at time of registration. This guarantees a reservation in a class.
- Fall tuition is due the first lesson of each month. Late fees apply after the second lesson.
- Fall tuition is the same each month. Students may make-up lessons if possible.
- Multiple discount programs are available. Please inquire the front desk for more info.
- Brochures provide specifics on rates, discounts and costume expenses. Grab one!

DANCEWEAR & SHOE REQUIREMENTS

Many of you have inquired regarding what your dancer should wear to class. Form-fitting yet comfortable dancewear is highly recommended for class. Examples include leotard and tights, tank top and shorts, or t-shirts and leggings. In general, dancers should be able to move but at the same time allow the instructors to improve the dancer's technique. Dancewear is available at the boutique.

The following shoes are REQUIRED for class. Each are available for purchase at the studio. It is highly recommended you purchase these shoes prior to the first week of class. It is extremely busy that first week and at times, we do not have the best size for your dancer in-stock. Stop by the studio during open houses to order any dance shoes needed.

- Tots: Pink ballets
- Preschool: White taps, pink ballets
- Kindergarten: White taps, pink ballets
- 1st/2nd: Tan taps, pink ballets
- 3rd/5th Beg/Int: Tan taps, tan jazz
- 3rd/5th Int/Adv: Tan taps, pink ballets, tan jazz
- 6th/8th: Tan taps, tan jazz
- 8th/12th Tap/Jazz: Black taps, tan jazz
- Teen Lyrical: Foot Undeez
- Boys: Black taps, black ballet or jazz
- Hip-Hop: Clean street shoe/sneaker

Finally, place dance shoes in a bag that your child can identify easily. Each dancer will bring his/her bag into the classroom. Like dancewear and shoes, dance bags may be purchased at the studio. Most importantly, LABEL your dancer's shoes! During the first week of class, instructors will be labeling shoes if not already labeled by the parent. Dance bags and labeled shoes make it less likely to lose dance shoes. Thank you for your cooperation!

Q: What Do You Offer ?

A: We offer a wide range of dance styles from ages 18 months to adult including tap, ballet, jazz, lyrical, hip-hop, and creative movement classes. Always be on the lookout for newly added classes (like belly dancing!) focused on the latest trends and dance techniques.

Q: What Is Your Philosophy ?

A: We aim to provide quality instruction that not only develops technical ability but also self-discipline, confidence and creativity. Also, we aim to be age-appropriate with respect to music, choreography, and costuming. Most importantly, we strive to make your experience a delightful and memorable one!

Q: Do You Do Competitive Dance?

A: Yes! We are in the process of evaluating dancers for groups who will enter anywhere between 3 and 5 competitions this coming school year. Fall Dance 2010-2011

It is time to register for the 2010-2011 dance season! Following is important information to help you make a decision regarding you or your dancer's education at Lake Area Dance Center.

Additions & Changes For Fall 2010-2011 Students:

Lake Area Dance Center has created a number of new classes and made a few changes to suit our families' and dancers' needs better. Please see our new brochure effective June 2010 for all additions and changes. Please note this September through May schedule carefully as some changes include new classes and minor changes to existing class levels!

Important Fall 2010-2011 Registration Dates:

June 14th – CURRENT students who register before this date will be given priority.

June 15th – Registrations from NEW SUMMER students will begin to be processed.

July 1st – Registrations from NEW students will begin to be processed.

Registrations may be handed in at the studio, mailed to our address, or sent online at <http://www.lakeareadance.com>. Phone registrations are discouraged.

Requirements for Fall 2010-2011 Registration:

Registration forms must be completed with payments for: (1) registration fee and (2) first month's tuition. Registration fees are \$12 per individual or \$20 per family; this fee occurs once per dance season. Please refer to the schedule and/or our brochure for September tuition.

Spots will not be held without a complete form, paid registration fee, AND paid first month's tuition. Additionally, account balances must be paid in full in order to reserve your dancer's place in a class this upcoming season.

There is no refund on registration fees. If a cancellation is made prior to August 1st, first month's tuition will be refunded. September tuition will not be refunded after August 1st.

Be sure to include your first and second choice for class times. You will receive a confirmation postcard indicating you or your dancer's class day and time during the summer months. *Class begins Tuesday, September 7th.*

Age 3-5: Forty-five minute combination class of basic Tap and Ballet along with Creative Movement and Tumbling.

Adult Tap, Belly Dancing or Hip-Hop: Forty-five minute classes for all levels of proficiency.
